

Declaration of the British Community

The British Community (BC) will set up autonomous administration entities in England, Wales and also in Cornwall, which by determination of democratic opinion may be extended further.

Residents of the Isle of Mann will be asked in a referendum whether or not they wish to be part of the BC. If so, this entity will have co-equal status with those of other administration entities.

Ulster or any part of it will not be in the BC, unless the government of the Republic of Ireland requests the contrary and this is the democratically decided opinion of the BC.
