

Interface with the UK area. Defence of BC structures and open control

Some definitions

- Insight and delusion are basically the same thing. Insight turns out to be right. Delusion turns out to be wrong.
- A delusion about control is a paranoia.
- Something which ought to be a delusion, but turns out to be correct is a revelation.

Note that a plenitude of paranoias may be sufficient to provide a defence when one of them turns out to be correct. Steve Jobs, the founder and former CEO of Apple said: In this business only the paranoid survive.

The paranoia that the UK government may take control of BC computer systems, inspect their contents, or otherwise direct the way in which they are to be used, is one that is avoided by locating these systems in Scotland, which will become independent after hard Brexit, and Waterford in the Republic of Ireland, which is not part of any UK administration at the time of writing and never will be.
