

The System

It is often recognised that the system does not work. In extending slightly its standard mode of operation it usually fails. What is understood only by a few is that it is designed to fail. The reason is the system is not benign or benevolent. Its motivation is anti-social, and if provoked it is violent. Faced with a threat to reveal exactly its nature and to replace it with a system of rational administration in the service of the community, it is genocidal.

The purpose of this little note is to provide protocols of behaviour to live in such a system. It also gives a few examples that may lead the reader to understand the way the system operates, why these examples are not abnormal, and to leave it at that.
